About the Symposium

This unique course is designed for the practicing urologist, gynecologist, and colorectal surgeon interested in updating his/her knowledge in the diagnosis, evaluation, and management of female pelvic floor disorders. - Decrease the rate of graft erosions/infections by understanding the proper usage and indications for graft usage tailored to each patient
- Expand surgical modalities for incontinence and prolapse based on an improved understanding of surgical procedures proven to be beneficial in treating pelvic floor problems

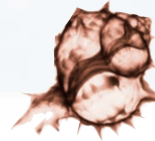
